

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MIUTES

December 11, 2012

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at Fire Station No. 2.

NEW BUSINESS

Tracey made a motion to appoint George Bliss, Matthew Bonnett, Walter Nows and alternate Marie Watts to the Munro Township Board of Review. Nows supported the motion. Motion carried.

Walter Nows received an estimate of graveling and seal coating ½ mile of Silver Strand Road. Mr. Nows asked how much the township was willing to contribute towards the project before he notified the property owners how much it would cost to pave the road. The plan was to place 6" of gravel on the road, wait a year, than seal coat after the road has settled. Ed Ginop said it would be hard to quote a job two years in advance with the price of oil going up and down. Mr. Nows said he would contact the seal coating company and report back at the next meeting.
