

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES

May 12, 2015

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag.

1. PAC Sanitation bid was accepted for door to door pickup on May 23rd.
2. William Hartwig wrote a letter about PIE & G being denied a natural gas franchise in Munro Township.
3. Contract was signed by Supervisor for the Cheboygan County Humane Society grant.
4. Contract for MacArthur Law Firm for 2015-2016 was signed by Supervisor and Clerk.

NEW BUSINESS
