

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

November 10, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Antkoviak at 7:30 p.m. at the fire hall.

CITIZENS AND GUEST COMMENTS

1. Cheboygan Co. Drain Commissioner, Dennis Lennox, reported on the public hearing to restrict the recreational harvesting of walleye from Mullett Lake. Mr. Lennox asked for support on his running for State Representative in next year's election.
2. Mr. Ralph Ferraiuolo presented the board with a cemetery sign proposal. Design and materials were shown to the board. Price would be \$800.00.

Mandrick made the motion to accept the price of \$800.00 for the cemetery sign, supported by Tracey. Motion carried.

Tracey made the motion to pay the monthly bills amounting to \$3,291.86, supported by Dotski.
Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. Copy of the Cheboygan County ORV map was reviewed. Board approved the map with no changes.
2. Great Lakes Energy – Notice of hearing of power supply cost recovery plan.
3. FEMA – Flood Insurance. Munro Township is not in a Special Flood Hazard area.
4. Cheboygan County Humane Society sent a contract for animal control services. The humane society asks each township for a donation to keep the shelter running. Mandrick made a motion to donate \$250.00 in next year's budget. Tracey supported the motion.

OLD BUSINESS

Marie Watts complained about N. Extension Road being so bad it was hard to drive down it. It was explained that the wet rainy weather hasn't helped any roads in the township. Every gravel road is reported to be full of holes. Antkoviak will speak with the road commission about grading the roads.
