

# MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

March 9, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Antkoviak at 7:30 p.m. at Fire Station No. 2.

## MINUTES

Marie Watts stated that in February's minutes, the Census Bureau official's name was spelled wrong, instead of Ann March; it should have been spelled Marsh.  
Tracey made the motion to accept the February 9, 2010 meeting minutes with the correction of Ms. Marsh's name, supported by Mandrick. Motion carried.

## PAYMENT OF BILLS

Mandrick made the motion to pay the February bills amounting to \$2,584.19, supported by Tracey. Motion carried.

## NEW BUSINESS

Board of Review for 2010 had five people come before the board and three letters were received.

Settlement Day will be March 15, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fire Station No. 2. At this time the budget will be prepared for 2010-2011.

Antkoviak will meet with Randy Bricker of the Pellston Fire Department and ask why the 2010-2011 fees were not lowered because of the decline in the township's taxable valuation. Inverness Fire Department's fees went down \$5,575.00 from last year.

Mandrick made the motion to accept the 2010-2011 fire fees for Inverness Fire Department.

Operating Fees are \$9,710.00 and Equipment Fees are \$3,300.00. Tracey supported the motion. All favored saying "Aye". Motion carried.


## OLD BUSINESS

Bids for the Annual Trash Clean Up Day was awarded to J & N Disposal. Winning bid was \$31.00 per cubic yard. PAC Sanitation's bid was \$36.00 per cubic yard. Ginop made the motion to accept J & N's bid of \$31.00 and to have a two (2) yard container for the township park on an on-call basis for \$30.00 per month during the summer season. Tracey supported the motion. Motion carried.

## CITIZENS COMMENTS

Mr. Matthew Raines asked why N. Extension Road can't be fixed. There are two problem areas that need attention by the road commission. Antkoviak explained that he already notified the road commission at their Annual meeting. N. Extension Road is a Primary Road and is the responsibility of Cheboygan County Road Commission. The CCRC meetings are twice a month at 9:00 a.m. in Indian River. The CCRC will not have night meetings for the public that works and can not attend the morning meetings.

A motion by Mandrick, supported by Tracey to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
