

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

July 13, 2010

PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Mandrick.

OTHERS PRESENT: Walter Nows, Paul Nows and Edward Ginop.

The meeting was held at the Munro Township Hall at 7:30 p.m. Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order with the pledge to the flag.

BILLS – Tracey made the motion to pay the June bills amounting to \$8,730.28, supported by Mandrick. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. The Cheboygan County Swimming Pool Committee gave each township a copy of the proposed plans.
2. Tim MacArthur handed out copies of Blight Ordinance Issues for townships who may be considering a Blight Ordinance.
3. Cheboygan County zoning Department denied Bill Hartwick on building a house.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Walter and Paul Nows asked Antkoviak to contact Team Services to brine Silver Strand Road that is all graded.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Election inspectors for the Primary election are Judith Ardune, Cecile Makowski, Sally Miller and Nancy Cemezlar.
2. Ginop reported that the State has contacted the township that the back entrance to the township hall has to be paved for disabled voters. Ginop contacted Rieth-Riley on a price for paving, cost would be \$3,781.00, and she also contacted Michigan Pavement Guard but received no response back. Ginop Construction's proposal to prep the driveway by stripping the sod off, replace with 22A gravel, grade to blacktop edge with gravel or topsoil after blacktop is placed for \$950.00. The State of Michigan also said the pavement must be striped for handicap parking. Don made the motion to get a second price from Spierling Trucking & Excavating for paving, Mandrick second the motion. Motion carried. Mandrick will get the striping paint and equipment to do the job ourselves.
3. Walter Nows explained to the board that Mr. Weber on Wilson Drive put up a gate to protect his property. There was a discussion on putting a gate on a county road, no decision was made.
