- Cheboygan County Planning Commission approved a Special Use Permit for Matthew Raines for an auto repair/service business on N. Extension Road. Mr. Raines has to comply with the Building Code specs for his building before he gets the permit. Marie Watts, a next-door neighbor is not pleased with the decision, stating that she can hear the repair noises inside her home with the windows shut.
- NEMCOG has a transportation meeting at Hillman on January 25th. NEMCOG will help communities get transportation grants.
- Antkoviak reported that he received his assessing certificate from the State of MI.
