

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

March 13, 2012

PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey ABSENT: Mandrick

Charles Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at the fire hall.
Pledge to the flag was recited.

MINUTES – Motion by Tracey, supported by Dotski to accept the minutes of February
14, 2012. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Motion by Tracey, supported by Ginop to pay the February
bills amounting to \$4,015.55. Motion carried.

CITIZENS COMMENTS

Walter Nows attended the Cheboygan County Road Commission meeting. Mr. Nows
reported that the new manager was very pleasant to talk to and would work with Silver
Strand residents and the township board to get Silver Strand Road project going. Mr.
Nows asked if the township would be willing to help pay for some of the costs to raise
the road up a half mile long. Ginop said there was money in the Road Fund; it depended
on how much the project would cost.

CORRESPONDENCE

FEMA sent a letter stating that Munro Township is not in the flood plain.

OLD BUSINESS: Set the 2nd meeting date for the proposed budget hearing for fiscal
year 2012-2013 on Monday, March 19, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at the fire hall on Levering Rd.

Board of Review had nine people show up about their taxes.

NEW BUSINESS

Ginop asked about putting a fire millage proposal on the August Primary ballot. The
township spends over \$25,000.00 on fire protection out of the General Fund. The other
three townships in the Joint Fire Board have fire millages. Antkoviak will check out
what a .5 mill or .75 mill would bring in.

Antkoviak reported that he needs a new computer with assessing software that is
compatible with the Cheboygan County Equalization Department. A New laptop would
be about \$500.00. Charles will get the price on the BS & A Software for the next
meeting.

BUDGET

The Board worked on the budgets for 2012-2013. The second hearing will be Monday, March 19th at 7:00 p.m. at the fire hall.

Ginop made the motion to adjourn at 9:15 p.m., supported by Dotski.
