

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

August 14, 2012

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at the Munro Township Hall. Pledge to the flag was recited.

MINUTES – Tracey made the motion to accept the July 10, 2012 meeting minutes, supported by Dotski. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Tracey made the motion to pay the July bills amounting to \$4,650.47, supported by Mandrick. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. Governor's office sent a letter thanking the township for supporting keeping the DNR money for land purchases.
2. Munetrix advertising their software program.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Cheboygan County Road Commission sent a quote for upgrading Silver Strand Road with gravel. Cost for 3,000 feet, 6" thick by 22' wide is \$38,697.98. Paul Nows and Antkoviak are going to the next meeting to get more details.
2. The Township fire millage passed by 8 votes.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Sally Miller suggested that the township ask for volunteers on the website to help with weeding and mulching future projects. Volunteers helped spread the mulch at the fire hall this week.
2. Antkoviak filled out a FEMA report.
3. Roger Skrobeck blocked off the two-track trail going through his property. A lot of people have used this trail for years and are now upset about the closing. Legal issues need to be addressed to see if Mr. Skrobeck can close the road.
4. Next Michigan Townships Assn. Meeting will be held at the Munro Township Hall on Thursday, August 30, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.
5. Election results for the Primary Election were reviewed. One hundred thirty-six people voted in Munro Township.

Tracey made the motion to adjourn the meeting, supported by Mandrick, the meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
