

Munro Township Board Meeting

March 12, 2013

PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows.

Guests: George Bliss, Matthew Bonnett, Marie Watts, Edward Ginop & Cheboygan Road Manager Mike Roper.

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. at Fire Station No. 2.
Pledge to the flag was recited.

Tracey made the motion to accept the February 14, 2013 meeting minutes as presented, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

Tracey made the motion to pay the February bills amounting to \$6,092.53, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

CITIZENS /GUESTS COMMENTS – Mr. Mike Roper, Manager of the Cheboygan County Road Commission introduced himself as the new Road Manager. Mr. Roper is trying to attend every Township meeting, asking every Township to support a road fund millage to help fix the roads. Currently the roads are breaking apart due to the changes in the weather. As soon as they fix one pot hole, another one appears. Munro has 1886 yards of gravel left for the coming year.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. NEMCOG is having a Planning and Zoning meeting for watershed protection.
2. Dave Stempkey from the DNR asked if Munro Township would be in favor of dredging the boat ramp at the Douglas Lake. Bar.
3. MTA is having an assessing workshop.
4. Mr. Patrick Maloney asked that the township reimburse him \$125.00 for the fee he paid to the State Tax Tribunal. Mr. Maloney did not follow the procedure to go before the Munro Board of Review first to correct the assessing mistake, therefore the township will not reimburse the fee.

OLD BUSINESS

Supervisor Antkoviak and Clerk Ginop attended the Cheboygan County Master Plan Meeting. No new changes, every township agreed to the new plan.

NEW BUSINESS

Budgets for all funds were discussed. Final budget hearing will be held Monday, March 18th, 7:00 p.m. at the fire station on Levering Road.

METRO agreement was discussed. Agreement for cable, phone companies using township right-of-way must pay the township fees. Agreement is for 5 years, April 1, 2013 to March 31, 2018. Ginop made the motion to accept the METRO agreement, supported by Tracey. All favored saying “Aye”. Motion carried.

Tracey made the motion to adjourn, supported by Nows. The meeting ended at 9:20 p.m.
