

MUNRO TOWNSHIP MEETING MINUTES

July 9, 2013

PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows

RESIDENTS & GUESTS PRESENT: PIE & G Brian Burns, Ed Ginop, Marie Watts, Richard Gedert, Patrick Keiser, Robert Watz, Robert Miller and Randy Keen.

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Pledge to the flag was recited.

MINUTES – Tracey made the motion to approve the June 11, 2013 meeting minutes as presented, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Ginop made the motion to pay the June bills amounting to \$8,496.70, supported by Tracey. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. A T & T sent a METRO ACT Right-of-Way Extension. Board approved the extension.
2. Enbridge asked if anyone sees a pipe leak to dial 911.

OLD BUSINESS (Unfinished) – None

NEW BUSINESS

1. Mr. Brian Burns of PIE & G asked the Munro Township Board to approve a 30-year franchise agreement for natural gas. Mr. Burns said that the possibility of Munro Township getting natural gas in all areas is very slim because the population is not there. Antkoviak made the motion to adopt the ordinance, supported by Tracey. Roll call vote: Antkoviak, Yes – Ginop, Yes – Dotski, Yes – Tracey, Yes and Nows, Yes. Ordinance was approved.
2. The DNR is no longer going to dredge or maintain the boat ramp on Douglas Lake next to the Douglas Lake Bar. Mr. Richard Gedert, Patrick Keiser and Robert Watz asked the Board if Munro Township would take over the responsibility of the boat ramp. The Cheboygan County Road Commission owns the dead end road and does not wish to have the liability of the boat ramp, neither does Munro Township. Ginop asked if Antkoviak could check with Burt Township on what they did with their boat ramps. Antkoviak will also check with Township Attorney, Tim MacArthur about possibly turning over the dead end road to the Douglas Lake Association.
3. Robert Miller and Randy Keen asked about more speed limit signs on Munro Lake Drive. Currently there is only two 25 miles per hour speed signs, one on each end of Munro Lake Drive. Board approved four more signs.

Nows made the motion to adjourn at 8:20 p.m. Supported by Tracey.
