

Munro Township Minutes of August 13, 2013 Meeting

PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Pledge to the flag was recited.

Tracey made the motion to accept the July 9, 2013 meeting minutes as presented, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

NEW BUSINESS – Antkoviak attended the opening of the Burt Lake Trail.

There are 80-20 funds for local safety systems through the Cheboygan County Road Commission.

Matthew Bonnett is having problems with the County about his bird hunting preserve. Ginop has given Mr. Bonnett a copy of the minutes stating Munro Township approved his Bird Hunting Preserve back in 2000.

Ginop asked that the women's bathroom toilet be fixed for the MTA Meeting held August 28th. Dotski said she could ask the lady that cleans Burt Township Hall if she would clean Munro Hall.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Holly Gedert of the Douglas Lake Association reported that the Association had a meeting concerning the DNR's getting out of dredging the boat ramp next to the Douglas Lake Bar. The Cheboygan County Road Commission owns up to the waters edge. They will reposition the cement ramps but will not dredge far out into the water. It was suggested that the sand dredged from the ramp be removed and Afton stone placed so the sand does not wash back in on top of the ramp. Cost should be paid for by the Douglas Lake Association.
2. Four new 25 Mph speed limit signs were placed on Munro Lake Drive.
