

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Meeting held at Fire Station No. 2

November 12, 2013

Board Members Present: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows
Guests: Wilfred Mandrick, Marie Watts, Holly and Richard Gedert, Ed Ginop and Robert Ulrich.

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag.

MINUTES – Tracey made the motion to accept the October 8, 2013 meeting minutes with the correction of *She has someone who would build the dock as a donation*, instead of boat. Nows second the motion. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Nows made the motion to pay the October bills amounting to \$5,121.01, supported by Tracey. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Robert Ulrich of Inland Lakes Snowmobile Club asked for the township's support to get permission from U of M Biological Station to use their property along the power line and seasonal roads to connect their trails from Mullett Lake to Pellston. Nows made the motion, support from Tracey to support the I.L.S.A. to get a snowmobile trail through the Biological Station property. All favored saying "Aye".

CORRESPONDENCE

1. Dept. of Licensing – Video Service Franchise
2. Harold Koviak, Supervisor of Burt Township, informed Munro Township of Burt's future plans to build a fire substation at Riggsville and West Burt Lake Road. Pellston Fire Department would service the fire station.
3. Cheboygan County Resolution – Encourage the Cheboygan County Road Commission and Townships within Cheboygan County to maintain public access of road ends and easements to water bodies to permit public access and use.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Cheboygan County Road Commission sent out Annual Maintenance contract for Silver Strand Road. Ginop already billed the seven property owners that are involved with the contract.
2. Great Up North Marketing is asking the Townships within Cheboygan County to participate in their marketing of Cheboygan County to promote tourism, travel and residency. A \$50,000.00 campaign advertising budget is proposed, Munro's share would be \$2,382.00 a year for 3 years. MTA has already passed a resolution in support of Great Up North Marketing Alliance. Decision is tabled until more information is available from other townships.

OLD BUSINESS

Holly Gedert asked about a Blight Ordinance for the township. There is a need in the township but who would enforce the ordinance. Cheboygan County does not want to spend money enforcing the ordinance therefore the townships would have to do it themselves.

Supervisor Antkoviak heard that the DNR is "looking" at Reinhardt's property as a possible boat launch site on Douglas Lake.

Tracey made the motion to adjourn at 8:25 p.m., supported by Dotski. Motion carried.
