

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, Tracey and Nows

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order with the Pledge to the Flag.

MINUTES – Tracey made the motion to accept the April 8, 2014 meeting minutes as presented, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Tracey made the motion to pay the bills amounting to \$5,879.21, supported by Nows. Motion carried.

CITIZENS COMMENTS

1. Linda Heller of Munro Lake Drive said her neighbor's security light shines into her home. She asked if there was anything that could be done. She has already talked with the neighbor and he is not willing to move or change the light. She offered to purchase a motion detection light instead of his security light but he refused. Antkoviak will check with the County.
2. Linda Orlow who lives on MacArthur Road asked about gravel on MacArthur Road, she also asked about a Junk Ordinance that Burt Township has in place. Antkoviak and Nows will speak to Burt Township's Supervisor and find out what kind of ordinance they have and how they enforce the ordinance.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. Holly Gedert of the Douglas Lake Association said that the Cheboygan County Road Commission needs a letter from Munro Township requesting that the CCRC apply for the DEQ Seasonal dock permit, next to the Douglas Lake Bar.
The application fee is \$10.00 the Douglas Lake Assn. will reimburse the township.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Beckman is spreading the road brine this year; cost is \$.215 per gallon.
2. Bid for grass cutting for the cemetery and hall went to Roger Gaynor for a total of \$2,300.00 for the 10 cuttings. If paid in full up front, the bid was \$2,000.00. No other bids were received. Ginop made the motion to accept Gaynor's bid of \$2,000.00, supported by Dotski. Motion carried.
3. Cheboygan County Treasurer has a piece of property in Munro Township up for sale for taxes. Munro has first choice to purchase, the township declined to purchase.
4. Nieland & Kosanke sent a contract to audit the township books for \$4,200.00. Ginop made the motion to accept the contract for \$4,200.00, supported by Dotski. Motion carried.
5. Cheboygan County Community Development asked the township to fill out a survey on Recreational vehicles on Lake and residential properties.
