

# MUNRO TOWNSHIP MEETING MINUTES

March 10, 2015

## Correspondence

- Cheboygan Co. Road Commission asking if Munro Township would like to have their cracking roads sealed. Ed Ginop and several others said it was a waste of money. Money should be spent on gravel alongside the blacktop to prevent the blacktop from crumbling.
- Munro Township Board appointed Ed Ginop as the PIE & G liaison board member.
- Trustee Paul Nows wrote a letter stating that he was on vacation and would miss the next two budget meetings but he is in favor of purchasing Afton stone for the roads.

## Public Comments

- County Chris Brown reported that he is attending meetings and attending training sessions for County Commissioners. Burt Township has applied for another grant for their non-motorized trail.

## Old Business – None

**New Business** – Proposed fiscal year budget for 2015-2016 was gone over for all funds. Major purchases will be Afton stone for the roads. A costly project to cut out and build Indian Trail Road off South Extension Road would need to be addressed to the Cheboygan County Road Commission for estimates. Ginop said she's heard about this road being bad for over 25 years; maybe it's time to do something about it. Silver Strand Road needs gravel to raise that road up also.

The old outside door going into the backroom in the basement of the hall needs to be replaced, that door is just a piece of tin, and Ginop said toads are coming into the basement. The old kitchen sink needs to be replaced and new plumbing installed. Antkoviak said the plumbing is old and needs to be updated with new turn off valves. Second budget hearing meeting will be held, Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at Fire Station No. 2.

Ginop made the motion to adjourn at 9:10 p.m., supported by Tracey.
