## New Business

Trustee Paul Nows sent out 68 letters to property owners on Silver Strand Road asking if they would be interested in paying for Afton stone from Van Road to Ingleside Road. Twenty-eight responded “yes”, five “no”, and 27 have not responded. A few questions were asked about how the money was to be raised either a flat price per home owner or by special assessment. Some residents asked if they could be included, they live South of Van Road, past Imogene Drier. Antkoviak and Nows will attend the next Cheboygan County Road Commission meeting on Thursday, July 16<sup>th</sup>. At the next board meeting there should be more details on the proposed project.

John Wojciechowski of Burt Lake came before the board showing drawings of a proposed fire station that Burt Township would like to build in Munro Township, the property owned by the University of Michigan Biological Station. The property is located on Riggsville and West Burt Lake Road. Pellston Fire Department would be servicing the area with equipment and firemen. The Biological Station is very interested in the proposed fire hall.

## Old Business

Ginop made the motion, supported by Tracey to adopt the Procedures & Guideline, and the Summary of FOIA Procedures & Guideline Requests. Motion carried. FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) will be on the township's website.
