

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

October 13, 2015

Meeting held at the Munro Township Hall

Present: Antkoviak, Ginop, Dotski, and Nows Absent: Tracey

Guests: Co. Commissioner Chris Brown, Ed Ginop, Marie Watts, Holly & Richard Gedert and William Hartwig.

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag.

Minutes - Nows made the motion to approve the September 8, 2015 meeting minutes as presented, supported by Dotski.5 Motion carried.

Payment of Bills – Nows made the motion to pay the monthly bills amounting to \$6,133.02, supported by Dotski. Motion carried.

Correspondence

A letter from a concerned Douglas Lake Resident questioned about Trustee Paul Nows working with a committee to organize and sending out letters and petitions for the Silver Strand special road assessment. This resident thinks maybe Mr. Nows used his trustee title to influence property owners.

Public Comments

It was reported so far that 30 percent of the petitions sent out are in favor of the special assessment on Silver Strand Road. As of this date 59.5% of the total footage is for the assessment. Deadline for returning the petitions are later this month.

County Commissioner, Chris Brown reported that the County Board of Commissioners appointed Janice Eaton as the Equalization director until the end of the year. The county is working on wage and union contracts. The Cheboygan County Fair Board has agreed to stay with the county instead of going on their own. The recycle program is working well but the county may have to charge for certain items that cost more to haul away.

New Business - The DEQ issued a permit to Dennis Morse on Douglas Lake to stabilize his property shoreline.

MTA is against the qualified forest plan and is also against the new gas tax.

Mr. Dave Thompson is asking the board to review the 1995 agreement of any interest on the abandonment of Lake Street and South Street. The Cheboygan County Road Commission did not abandon the rest of North Street with a 12' alley.

Steve Ostwald would like to split his property with his brother Tim Ostwald.

The Cheboygan County Road Commission will hold a public hearing on October 22, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. about proposed road projects.
