Correspondence

New Business

1. Board of Review members, George Bliss, Richard Gedert and Marie Watts were sworn in as Board of Review Members.
2. PAC Sanitation of Onaway sent a quote of \$47.00 per compacted yard for the township's Annual Cleanup day in May. PAC is willing to work with the township to haul trash on Saturday, Memorial Day week-end. Nows made the motion, supported by Tracey to accept PAC's bid. Motion carried.
3. Linda Orlow reported that the Cheboygan County Road Commission truck driver is plowing too wide on MacArthur Road therefore hitting mailboxes and not stopping at intersections. Supervisor Antkoviak will talk to the manager at the next road commission meeting.

Old Business

Ethel MacArthur explained the next step in the process to establish a special assessment for Silver Strand Road. The public hearing of the tax roll will be postponed until March.

The first hearing on the proposed 2016-2017 fiscal year budget was discussed. Assessor Antkoviak asked for a \$2,500.00 raise for one year. Marie Watts objected to the raise, saying he got a \$4,000.00 raise last year. Ginop reported that after 42 years, she is not running this year as Clerk, she used her own equipment over the years, and therefore the township must purchase a new computer, typewriter and copier for the new Clerk. The second hearing on the budget will be at the March meeting.

Ginop made the motion to adjourn, supported by Tracey. The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
