

**MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING /MUNRO TOWN HALL
MAY 9, 2017**

Present: Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Paul Nows, Donald Tracey, and Charles Antkoviak.

Guests: There were 21 guests in attendance.

Supervisor Antkoviak called the meeting to Order at 7:30 p.m. with the pledge to the flag.

Minutes: Nows made the motion to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2017 meeting. Support to approve the minutes by Tracey. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: Nows made the motion to pay the bills amounting to \$5,240.76, supported by Tracey. Motion carried.

Correspondence: None.

Unfinished Business: DTE was to have representatives available after the meeting for any questions residents may have had, unfortunately the representatives went to the wrong hall and missed the meeting. William Hartwig was in attendance and graciously shared the information that he has gathered on the gas line with the group.

New Business: Fire Chief Dan Socha was present to address the Board and answer questions with the audience regarding the paving of the firehall parking lot. The matter was addressed at length. A Motion was made by Tracey to accept and approve Spierling Trucking & Excavating's bid of \$18,225.00 contingent upon the submission of a drawing outlining the project that meets the approval of the Board, supported by Nows. All in favor, Motion carried.

Fire Chief Socha asked the Board to purchase four (4) slip covers for the cement pillars that are located in front of the garage doors, the approximate cost being \$34.00 per cover. Motion made by Tracey to purchase the four slip covers, seconded by Nows. All in favor, Motion carried.

The Fire hall also needs a new septic lid cover, Chief Socha will pick one up from Cheboygan Cement and have the bill mailed to the Clerk.

The Munro Township Clean Up Bee is slated for May 20th, 2017.

The Munro Township Annual Clean Up day is May 27, 2017.

The issue of lawn maintenance for the cemetery and hall was discussed, we will approve an increase of \$25.00 per cut but no more. As of yet Country Cleaners had not officially submitted a proposal for the upcoming season. Supervisor Antkoviak will address the issue.

The next MTA meeting is May 25th at the Wilmot Township Hall.

The meeting was adjourned to the call of the chair at 8:40 p.m.
