Regular Board Meeting

Old Business: Supervisor Antkoviak addressed the group and gave a brief update of the Michigan Township Association (MTA) annual convention that he attended in Grand Rapids.

New Business: Fire Chief Socha spoke to the Board about several maintenance issues at the Fire Hall that need to be addressed. The ceiling/roof above the restrooms is leaking and the septic system froze this winter causing water to drain back into the hall. He has agreed along with Supervisor Antkoviak to contact the individuals who did the original work to address the issues and schedule the appropriate course of action for repairs.

Discussion was held in regards to dust control and any potential safety hazard that it posed. The Cheboygan County Road Commission (CCRC) has assured that the brine we use contains no radio-active material and meets all Michigan Department of Transportation safety requirements. If anyone is interested and would like more information on the matter they can access the CCRC website.

The Munro Township Annual Residential Cleanup Day is scheduled for Saturday, May 25, 2019 starting at 7:00 AM until each residence has been successfully serviced. Trash must consist of household items only, items such as concrete, yard debris, and hazardous items will not be accepted.
