

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Regular Board Meeting
March 9th, 2021
Munro Fire Hall, Levering, MI 49755

Board Members Present: Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, Ty Antkoviak and Don Tracey.

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

Agenda: Motion by Don Tracey to approve the Agenda, supported by Ty Antkoviak. Motion carried.

Minutes: Don Tracey made the motion to approve the February 9th, 2021 regular and budget workshop meeting minutes, supported by Cheryl Dotski. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: Don Tracey made the motion to pay the bills in the amount of \$10,152.74, supported by Ty Antkoviak. Motion carried.

Updates:

Fire Board: Clerk Bur and Trustee Tracey attended the meeting via ZOOM; the Board was supplied a copy of the Inverness Fire Board Budget.

MTA: No meetings due to Covid19.

Road Commission: Supervisor Ginop updated the Board as to the meeting he attended via Zoom. The CCRC has awarded the Dust Control and Brine Bid to American Waste, Incorporated utilizing a concentration 29-32% at .26 cents per gallon. There was discussion as to the Mograin Bridge (Orchard Beach Road) not making the list of bridges to be fixed, they may ask the Township's for a letter of support to forward to Lansing.

1st Public Comment/Unfinished Business: Marie Watts asked what bridge in Cheboygan County is on schedule to be worked on, it was reiterated as the Orchard Beach Road/Mograin Bridge needing repair work.

Correspondence: Clerk Bur shared an email she had received from Mike and Jan Holland asking permission to use the Munro Township Hall and outside perimeter of the cemetery for a metal detecting group excursion, after a lengthy discussion it was the decision of the Board to deny the request mainly due to unknown liability issues.

Supervisor Ginop received a letter in regards to the Pellston Public Library and the issuance of cards; a lengthy discussion was held, the matter is tabled for further research.

Unfinished Business: Clerk Bur made several suggestions to the proposed 2021-2022 budget, line items that could be reduced and amended if needed bringing the budget into alignment. Don Tracey made the motion to adopt the 2021-2022 Munro Township Budget, supported by Ty Antkoviak. Upon roll call, the following voted "Aye": Bur, Dotski, Antkoviak, Tracey and Ginop. "Nay": none. The Supervisor declared the 2021-2022 Munro Township Budget adopted.

A motion was made by Don Tracey to accept the Supervisor Salary Resolution for 2021-2022 setting the salary at the annual amount of \$10,000.00, supported by Ty Antkoviak. Upon roll call, the following voted "Aye": Bur, Dotski, Antkoviak, Tracey and Ginop. "Nay": none. The Supervisor declared the Supervisor Salary Resolution adopted.

A motion was made by Ty Antkoviak to amend the Clerk Salary Resolution to include payment of \$1,500.00 to the Clerk for hosting school elections, supported by Ty Antkoviak. Upon roll call, the following voted "Aye": Bur, Dotski, Antkoviak, Tracey and Ginop. "Nay": none. The Supervisor declared the Clerk Salary Resolution adopted.

The position of Cemetery Sexton and Assessor need to be addressed, the Clerk will post an advertisement for employment in the paper.

New Business:

A motion was made by Ty Antkoviak to adopt the 2021-2022 Inverness Fire Department Budget as presented, supported by Don Tracey. Upon roll call, the following voted "Aye": Bur, Dotski, Antkoviak, Tracey and Ginop. "Nay": none. The Supervisor declared the budget adopted.

Clerk Bur gave the Board and attendees a brief update as to the upcoming May 4, 2021 election, COP-ESD millage renewal, all supplies have been ordered.

As to the Munro Township Annual Residential Cleanup Day, Don Tracey made the motion that we accept the proposal from PAC Sanitation, securing the date of May 29th, 2021, supported by Cheryl Dotski. All in favor, motion adopted.

Second Public Comment: Assessor Charles Antkoviak reminded the Board that a Resolution to Waive Penalties for Non-Filing of Property Transfer Affidavits under MCL 211.27b. should be adopted by the Township, Clerk Bur will review to see if one is on file.

Kyle Keller asked that the subject of road repairs not be forgotten.

Adjournment: Motion by Ty Antkoviak to adjourn the meeting. Supported by Don Tracey. All in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30PM.
