

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES

April 13th, 2021

Board Members Present: Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, Ty Antkoviak and Don Tracey.

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

Correspondence: 1) Parcel Division Application from Joshua and Elsa Martin, Assessor Antkoviak has previewed the application and it meets all criteria. Motion by Ty Antkoviak to approve the Application, supported by Don Tracy. All in favor, motion carried.

2) Municipal Retainer Agreement with Attorney Timothy MacArthur for 2021-2022. Motion by Don Tracey approve the agreement, supported by Ty Antkoviak. All in favor, motion carried.

Unfinished Business: The position of Cemetery Sexton is going to be filled by Ryan Spies who currently does the lawncare for the cemetery. Supervisor Ginop will help with the location of lots and assist with any questions.

As to the Assessor position, a Motion was made by Don Tracey to continue with Charles Antkoviak on a monthly basis until the AMAR audit is complete, supported by Ty Antkoviak. A motion was made by Ty Antkoviak to adopt the Resolution to Waive Penalties for Non-Filing of Property Transfer Affidavit, supported by Don Tracey. All in favor. The Supervisor declared to Resolution adopted.

New Business: In regards to the cemetery the Supervisor will be the liaison with the Sexton. Supervisor Ginop suggested that we add lots #51-60 in Potter's Field to best utilize that section of property.
