

MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES
Regular Board Meeting
October 12th, 2021
Munro Township Hall

Board Members Present: Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, and Don Tracey.

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

Agenda: Motion by Don Tracey to approve the Agenda, supported by Paul Nows. Motion carried.

Minutes: Paul Nows made the motion to approve the September 14th, 2021 meeting minutes, supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: Don Tracey made the motion to pay the October 2021 bills in the amount of \$7,423.13, supported by Cheryl Dotski. Motion carried.

Updates:

Fire Board: Next meeting is 10/14/2021. **MTA:** Presentation on municipality insurance. **Road Commission:** No update to report.

1st Public Comment: Mary Ellen Sheridan did a brief photo board presentation pertaining to the deteriorating condition of the Douglas Lake Boat Ramp, she advised that the DLIA has created a new committee referred to as the “Boat Ramp Working Group”. Holly Gedert on behalf of Ron Witthoff gave a brief historical outline of the boat ramp. Clerk Bur has advised that she has reached out to EGLE to ask if we can modify the most recently obtained permit or if we need to apply for a new one. Ownership and responsibility are still the issue. Repair bids are being sought by the Boat Ramp Working Group and Supervisor Ginop.

Correspondence: Clerk Bur received a \$25.00 check and Land Division Request from Karen Andrews, Assessor Antkoviak has reviewed the same and states it meets all standard requirements. Motion by Don Tracey to approve the request, supported by Cheryl Dotski. All in favor, motion carried.

Unfinished Business: In regards to Trustee Paul Now’s recent request to forgo his pay as trustee, Clerk Bur reached out to the Michigan Township Association for their opinion. Clerk Bur received confirmation that the answer is no, a trustee may not choose to not accept payment as the pay is for the position not the person, so whoever holds the position of trustee is due that compensation. A copy of the response was forwarded to all members of the board via email.

New Business: The Cheboygan County Road Commission will be laying Afton Stone on certain portions of Heilman and Dotski Road.

Second Public Comment: Assessor Antkoviak attended and completed the eight-hour Assessor’s training in the Upper Peninsula, keeping his credentials up to date. Assessor Antkoviak reported to the Board that he will be completing his term and retiring the end of March 2022 after the submission and completion of the certified assessment roll. Clerk Bur will contact the MTA regarding the Assessor position and insurance.

Adjournment: Motion by Don Tracey to adjourn the meeting. Supported by Cheryl Dotski. All in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00PM.
