Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

**Agenda:** Motion by Don Tracey to approve the agenda, supported by Paul Nows. Motion carried.

**Approval of Minutes:** Paul Nows made the motion to approve the previous meeting minutes, supported by Keith Ginop. Motion carried.

**Payment of Bills:** Don Tracey made the motion to pay the July 2022 bills in the amount of \$34,293.52, supported by Cheryl Dotski. Motion carried.

**1st Public Comment:** Chief Executive Officer from Presque Isle Electric Thomas Sobek provided updates as to potential rate increases that will take effective September of 2022, the average residential customer will see an increase of approximately \$5.71 per month, seasonal customers can expect a monthly increase of \$3.34. The new headquarters construction has been completed, a brief update on current projects, brushing, a new pole to be installed on North Extension Road between Dotski Road and Wallace Road. A License Agreement was incorporated as an addendum to the motion.
