

**MUNRO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES**  
**Regular Board Meeting**  
**September 13th, 2022**

**Board Members Present:** Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, Paul Nows and Don Tracey.

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

**Agenda:** Motion by Paul Nows to approve the agenda, supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

**Approval of Minutes:** Don Tracey made the motion to approve the August 9th, 2022 regular board meeting minutes, supported by Paul Nows. Motion carried.

**Payment of Bills:** Paul Nows made the motion to pay the September 2022 bills, supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

**Updates:**

**Fire Board:** Fire Chief Socha went over fire runs, payment of bills. **MTA:** Jodi Ginop of Woods and Water Wellness gave a presentation on mental health awareness and available resources in our community. Harold Koviak advised of pending legislative updates. **Road Commission:** No update to report.

**1st Public Comment:** Cheboygan 53<sup>rd</sup> Circuit Court Chief Judge Aaron Gauthier was present and gave an update as to his Court procedures and programs.

Jeffrey Ostman introduced himself, he is running as the republican candidate for Cheboygan County Commissioner, District #1.

**Correspondence:** Clerk Bur received from Nieland & Kosanke a draft of the Financial Statements and Management Rep Letter, the audit is near completion.

**Unfinished Business:** Douglas Lake Boat Ramp: The billing payable to Spierling Trucking and Excavating in the amount of \$72,036.00 has been reviewed Huron Engineering, it is recommended that the payment be mailed upon final completion.

**Fire Hall Exhaust System:** Supervisor Ginop received an up to date bid in the amount of \$26,027.00 for a PlymoVent vehicle exhaust removal system for two (2) vehicles to be connected to the system with magnetic nozzle connection. If paid in advance we are eligible for a 3% discount. Motion by Supervisor Ginop to accept the bid paying in advance to receive the 3% discount, with a cap of \$26,000.00, to include paying for this expenditure with ARPA funds. Supported by Don Tracey, all in favor, motion carried.

**New Business:** In regards to the Blight Ordinance a motion was made by Paul Nows that all complaints should be presented to the Supervisor in writing, upon receipt the property in question will be reviewed by the Supervisor and one trustee with a recommendation to the Board at the next meeting. Supported by Don Tracey, all in favor, motion carried.
