Regular Board Meeting  
May 13th, 2025  
Munro Fire Hall**

**Board Members Present:** Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, Don Tracey. Al Antkoviak (excused absence).

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

**Agenda:** Mary Bur made the motion to approve the May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Agenda supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

**Approval of Minutes:** Don Tracey made the motion to approve the March 11<sup>th</sup> 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes and Budget Workshop Minutes, supported by Keith Ginop. Motion carried. The April Township Meeting was cancelled due to the ice storm.

**Payment of Bills:** Keith Ginop made the motion to pay the May 2025 bills in the amount of \$12032.88, supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

**Updates: Fire Board:** Report of all runs by Fire Chief and briefing on ice storm. **MTA:** Presentation from the Cheboygan Soil Conservation Office. **Cheboygan County Road Commission Meeting:** No update.

**Unfinished Business:**

- **Bids on Afton Stone:** Two bids received for 2,000 ton of Afton 23A Gravel; Darrow Brothers at \$18.50 per ton and EF Wilkinson at \$18.25 per ton. Motion by Keith Ginop to award the bid to the lowest bid/EF Wilkinson for 2,050 ton at the price of \$37,412.50. Supported by Cheryl Dotski. Upon roll call: all in favor except Al Antkoviak who was absent. Motion carried.
- **Brine:** We are on schedule for mid- June with A-1 Services.

**New Business:**

- **Blight:** Three separate complaints have been received by the Board, Motion by Ginop supported by Bur to forward the complaints to the Cheboygan County Sherriff's Office for enforcement. Motion carried.

**Public Comment:** Marie Watts voiced her displeasure with the Board approving an additional \$1,600.00 for the annual clean up of the cemetery for the destruction caused by the ice storm without a motion before the Board. Supervisor Ginop advised that it was a once in a century storm, the meeting was cancelled due to no heat or power at the hall and the cemetery was a hazard with pending burials.

William Hartwig spoke in support of the potential of a paving project at the Douglas Lake Boat Ramp.

**Adjournment:** Motion by Don Tracey to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 PM. Supported by Don Tracey. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
