New Business:

• **Blight**: Three separate complaints have been received by the Board, Motion by Ginop supported by Bur to forward the complaints to the Cheboygan County Sherriff's Office for enforcement. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Marie Watts voiced her displeasure with the Board approving an additional \$1,600.00 for the annual clean up of the cemetery for the destruction caused by the ice storm without a motion before the Board. Supervisor Ginop advised that it was a once in a century storm, the meeting was cancelled due to no heat or power at the hall and the cemetery was a hazard with pending burials.
