

Munro Township Regular Board Meeting
May 12th, 2026

Board Members Present: Mary Bur, Cheryl Dotski, Keith Ginop, Don Tracey and Al Antkoviak.

Supervisor Ginop called the meeting to Order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

Agenda: Don Tracey made the motion to approve the May 2026 Meeting Agenda, supported by Cheryl Dotski. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Don Tracey made the motion to approve the April 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes with the correction that Al Antkoviak was not present at the April meeting as noted, supported by Cheryl Dotski. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: Keith Ginop made the motion to pay the April 2026 bills in the amount of \$11,774.59, supported by Don Tracey. Motion carried.

Updates: Fire Board: Meeting cancelled. MTA: Road Commission updated and a presentation from the Indian River Library. Cheboygan County Road Commission Meeting: No update.

1st Public Comment: Discussion was held as to the procedure for appointing committee members, i.e., election workers and members of the Board of Review.

New Business:

- **Website:** Motion by Don Tracey to award the proposal to MCG, Inc. to update our current website bringing it to ADA compliance, supported by Bur. Motion carried.
- **Brine:** GFL will be disbursing the mineral well brine (29%-32%concentration).
- **Land Splits:** Supervisor Ginop will meet with Attorney MacArthur on the issue.
- **Cemetery:** Scott Brandau would like to purchase Lot #4 (46,47 & 48), \$120- each/\$360.00 as a non-resident. Mr. Brandau has requested to place a 3-foot cement pad in one lot an erect an American flag at that sight, he will place the flag and maintain it. Motion by Keith Ginop supported by Al Antkoviak to allow the flag and flag pole to be erected. Motion carried.

2nd Public Comment: William Hartwig requested that brine be placed on his road as in the past and he will pay for it. He also requested that the home in question on Bryant Road be followed up on in regards to the previously issued blight complaint. Supervisor Ginop will follow up on the Township's active blight complaints with the Cheboygan County Sherriff's Department (Byrant Road and North Extension Road). Discussion was held in regards to the lighted speed sign purchased by the Township, it's still not in operation. Supervisor Ginop to follow up on.
